Our residents have reported challenges contacting their local offices, and our team members have noted a higher-than-normal call volume. Since customer service and continuous improvement are paramount to our company culture, finding a replacement for our phone system became a priority.

The new phone system allows the Hunt Military Communities site teams to manage all calls through Service Cloud Voice. This system ensures site teams can gather contact information if a call drops. If a team member is away from their desk, the caller will automatically be routed to another team member to avoid missed calls. The best part is that no phone numbers will change, so you don't have to do anything. Just make sure to keep our number saved in your phone!

HMC is working to strengthen the resident experience; the first step is making communication with you seamless. We appreciate you as a part of our community, and look forward to your feedback about the new phone system.

Friendly Reminder: Pet Policy

Pets are privately owned, domesticated animals living in a home. Acceptable pets include dogs, cats, and birds. No more than two pets per household are allowed. Certain breeds of pets have been restricted and will not be accepted. These breeds include Pit Bull (American Staffordshire Bull Terrier or English Staffordshire Bull Terrier), Rottweiler, Doberman Pinscher, Chow Chows, and Wolf hybrids. The current list of restricted breeds can also be found in REDSTONE FAMILY HOUSING Pet Policy. All pet agreements prior to this revision will be grandfathered to accommodate prior residents.

All pets must be registered at the Veterinarian Treatment Facility within five working days of occupying a house or acquiring a pet. Pet owners must provide verification of appropriate immunization along with the pet registration to REDSTONE FAMILY HOUSING.

Resident must sign a separate Pet Addendum. Please refer to the Pet Addendum for associated fees and deposits. Any pet damages to the home will be applied and collected separately.

Pets must be on a leash at all times when outside the fenced area of a home. Pets cannot be tied or staked outside of the home. Residents who walk their pets must carry a plastic bag or other appropriate container to retrieve and dispose of any droppings.

If the resident or any guest violates any term of the pet policy, the resident will be subject to the remedies provided in the Lease.

Self-Help Shop

We offer a self-help program at our maintenance shop located at 1103 Mountain Drive. This is off Goss Road past the baseball fields and right beside the Fox Army Health Center up on the hill. You can borrow lawn mowers (For 24 hours ONLY), get grass seeds (For patch grass jobs ONLY), vent filters, touch-up paint (Please bring a personal container for fill-up), and specialty light bulbs. Vanity light bulbs and 60-watt light bulbs are not provided. All other items must use a work order to be replaced or repaired. The self-help shop is only open between the hours of 3:00 PM – 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday. Please DO NOT enter the self-help shop without an employee's approval. If you do arrive outside of the time specified above, we will not be able to give out any requested items.

Annual Preventative Maintenance

With the weather getting colder out there, be sure to test out your heating unit and make sure your air filters are changed for the new season. We will begin our annual preventative maintenance this month with our maintenance department which entails changing out air filters, checking on HVAC unit conditions, testing smoke alarms and CO Detectors, checking for structural damage, and pest control throughout the homes. Please note that a technician will not enter a home if there is a loose pet or a child younger than 18 years old in the home without a supervising adult.
